EXECUTIVE DEVELOPMENT

Executive Forum

A forum for executives of larger, established organizations to business owners and founders of smaller businesses. The Executive Forum is designed to increase the effectiveness of business leaders and consists of a 12-month educational process that will change the way you think. Within the twelve-month program, there are three one-week educational sessions designed as intensive, full-time commitments that allow leaders to concentrate on specific business topics related to the Survival, Growth and Expansion stages of business.

Forum Fees: \$15,000, \$5000 per week

Strategy Forum

An application-based forum for business leaders responsible for strategic leadership. Participants of the forum are guided through the process of building or refining strategies for their individual organizations. Case studies, various strategy planning frameworks and activities are used to enhance the capacity of executives to think and lead strategically.

Governance Forum

A forum for current or future board chairs, committee leaders, and advisors for both for-profit and non-profit organizations who have or plan to create a board of directors or board of advisors to enhance the effectiveness of board members and the value added by Advisory Boards and Boards of Directors as a whole.

Forum Fees: \$2500

Speed of Trust Forum
